Failure to submit this form duly signed, will disallow you from participation or entry

to the WC2016 - Sweden sites

- All persons associated with the FISAC World Championships and Sweden tournaments 2016 must adhere to the rules and guidelines outlined in the FISAC 2016 Rule Book and Tournament Guidelines. The Articles of Understanding must be signed for each tournament by each competitor and coach.

- All competitors must arrive at the competition site 30 minutes before the scheduled event. If a competitor does not respond by the third call for the event, they will be disqualified.

- Any questions concerning the rules or procedure of the tournament will be handled exclusively by the National team coach only and will be directed to the Tournament Director. Such questions should be made prior to the competitions.

- All participants agree to conduct themselves in a manner displaying good sportsmanship throughout the tournament. The national coach is responsible for seeing that the team members, coaches, parents and any other persons affiliated with the team conduct themselves accordingly. Severe cases of unsportsmanlike conduct are grounds for disqualification. The Tournament Committee shall have authorization to make the final determination as to what conduct constitutes "severe unsportsmanlike conduct." The decision of the Tournament Committee on this issue shall be final. Any inappropriate behavior on or off the site will result in an immediate expulsion of the person from the site and sent home with no chance of refund of monies paid. The Tournament Committee shall have authorization to make the final determination as to what inappropriate behavior on or off site will result in an immediate expulsion of an individual from the site and its determination shall be final. The Tournament Committee reserves the right in its discretion to contact local authorities.

- Be advised that on the evenings of any of the championships, it will be understood that reasonable quiet shall prevail and be enforced throughout the camp residences. This will be the responsibility of all country coaches

- Any interpretation of any aspect of these Articles of Understanding or any decision involving any of the aspects of the tournament will be rendered by the Tournament Committee. The Tournament Committee will render judgment in an effort to insure that the tournament proceeds in a manner consistent with the general spirit and goals of the tournament.

- By participating in the Championship, each competitor agrees that the decisions by the judges and Tournament Committee will be final and will not be subject for review. Each competitor acknowledges the necessity for the judges to make prompt and fair decisions in the competition and each competitor waives any legal, equitable, administrative or procedural review of such decisions.

- Any competitor or coach that does not adhere to the terms and procedures of the "Articles of Understanding" may be disqualified from the tournament and automatically forfeit the right to any awards presented by the tournament. In addition, the competitor may also forfeit the opportunity to participate in any qualifying tournaments and (or) any future World tournaments.

- Only athletics (skippers) and the coaches designated by their respective countries will have authorized access to the games field and the designated locker room areas. This includes designated practice and warm up areas. No Parents or spectators will be allowed.

- Anyone, not authorized, found in these areas will be escorted immediately out the building by security and refused access for the remaining championship term.

In consideration of your acceptance of this application, we (or) I hereby release board members and any persons associated with FISAC-IRSF and/or SGF, as its designated host federation, from all claims and causes of action arising from injury to the participant in this Championships, whether such injury is the result of negligence or some other cause. I (Guardian and /or Participant) hereby indemnify, release, hold harmless and forever discharge FISAC-IRSF, its Board of Directors and SGF from any and all claims, demands, expenses, causes of action, lawsuits, damages, liability of every nature, whether known or unknown, in law or equity that I/Participant may have arising from the competition at the tournament and attendance at the tournament. This Release extends to include negligence and intentional conduct. This Release is binding on Guardian of Participant, Parents of Participants, Participant, and all assigns and legal representatives of Participant. If any provision herein is determined invalid, the remaining provisions will continue to have full force and effect allowed by law. If medical attention is required for injury or illness while at the tournament, we (or) I give my permission for such medical care and we (or) I will be financially responsible for such medical care. By signing this form we (or) I attest that we (or) I have a valid medical insurance coverage plan.

If Participant is under the age of 18 at the start of the event, but has a birthday during the event, both the Participant and guardian must sign. This Release is written to extend the fullest protection allowed by law to FISAC-IRSF. Where "I/we/participant" are used herein, it is the intent that the Guardian of Participant sign this document, if the Participant has not reached eighteen years of age.
